## Narrative history

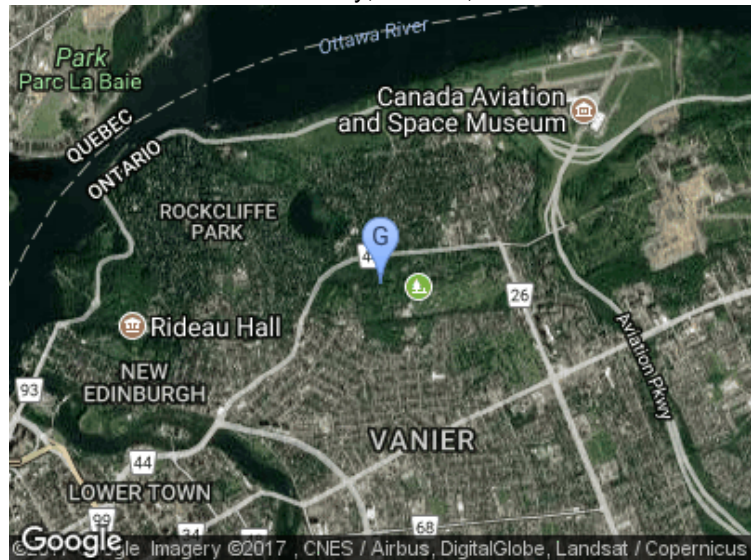
319875 Gunner (51st Battery, Canadian Field Artillery) Alexander (Alex) Rennie (b.1894) of Ottawa died 19160522 and is buried at Beechwood cemetery, Ottawa, Ontario. He was the son of David and Catherine Rennie of Clarks Crossing. Alex was born at Leswalt, Dumfries & Galloway, Scotland, and was working as a car checker when he enlisted at Ottawa four months before his death. There is no cause of death given in his file.

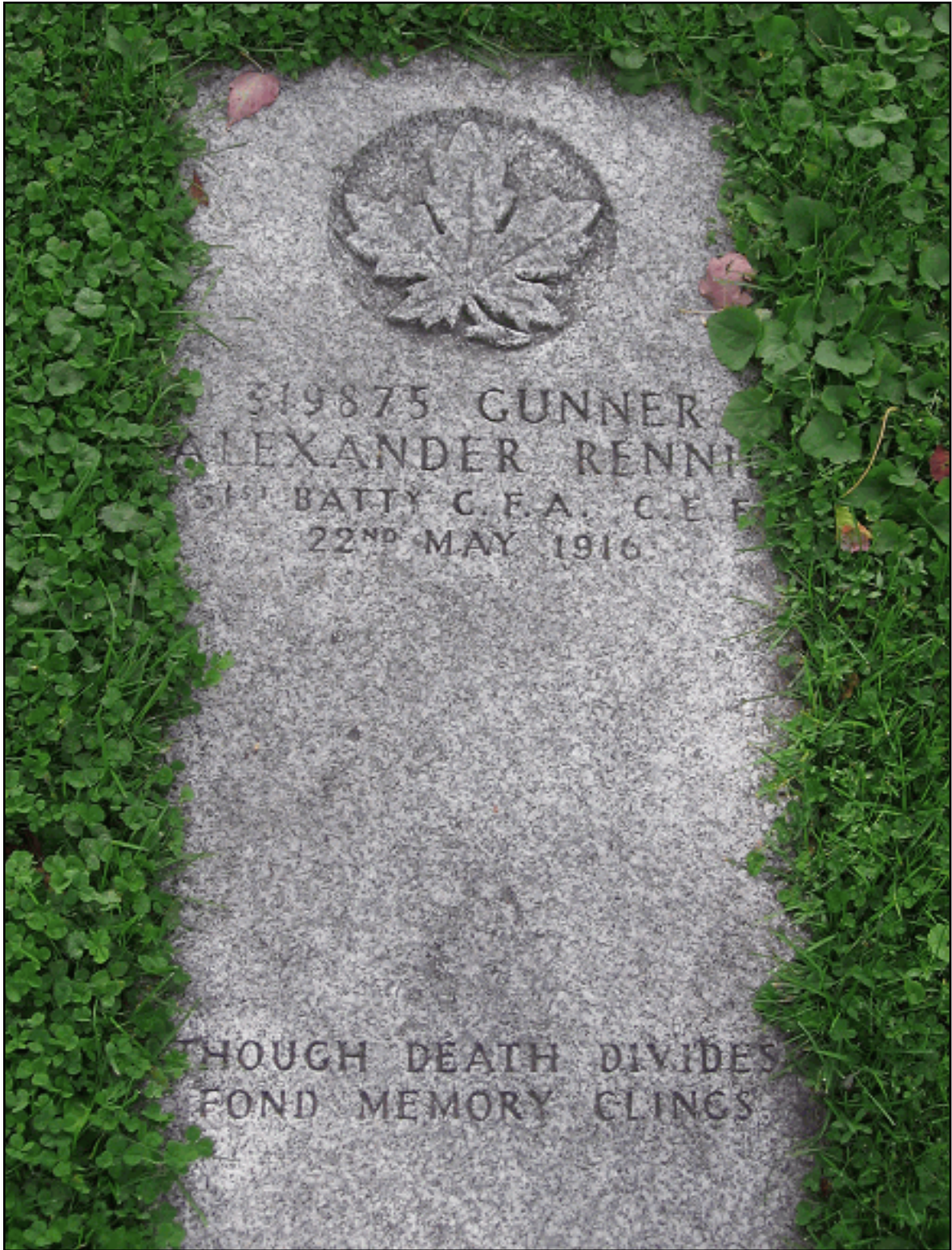
