Narrative history

106526 Sergeant (1st Canadian Mounted Rifles, Saskatchewan Regiment) James Ross (b.1881) of Saskatoon was KIA 19160928 at Thiepval Ridge and is commemorated on the Vimy Memorial north of Arras, Pas-de-Calais, for the 11,000+ Canadian soldiers who perished in northern France with no known grave. He was the son of Mrs. G. Lampard of Dauphin, Manitoba, and the late William A. Ross. James was born at London, Middlesex Co., Ontario, and was working as a salesman when he enlisted at Saskatoon on New Years Eve 1914.
