Narrative history

V10506 Able Seaman (HMCS Valleyfield) Percival George Carey (b.1915) of Regina was KIA 19440507 and is commemorated on the Halifax Memorial for servicemen lost or buried at sea. He was the foster son of George B. and Elsie Florence Carey. Percival was working as a B.A. service station attendant before serving two months in the Regina Rifles, then transferring to the Navy at Regina late in 1940.
