### **Narrative history**

J95491 Pilot Officer (No. 424 Tiger Squadron RCAF air gunner) Vernon Beverly (Babe) Smith (b.1925) of Regina was KIA 19450215 and is commemorated on the Runnymede Memorial near London, England, for airmen from the north European theatre who died with no known grave. Smith's Lancaster failed to return from a night mine laying flight off Pomerania. Babe spent a few weeks working as a labourer for Cominco at Trail, British Columbia, before enlisting at Vancouver in 1943.

Brother of GE Smith. They were the only sons of George Earl, a tinsmith, and Ona Pearl (Hoard) Smith, both Ontarians. Both boys attended Victoria school and Balfour Tech.
