## Narrative history

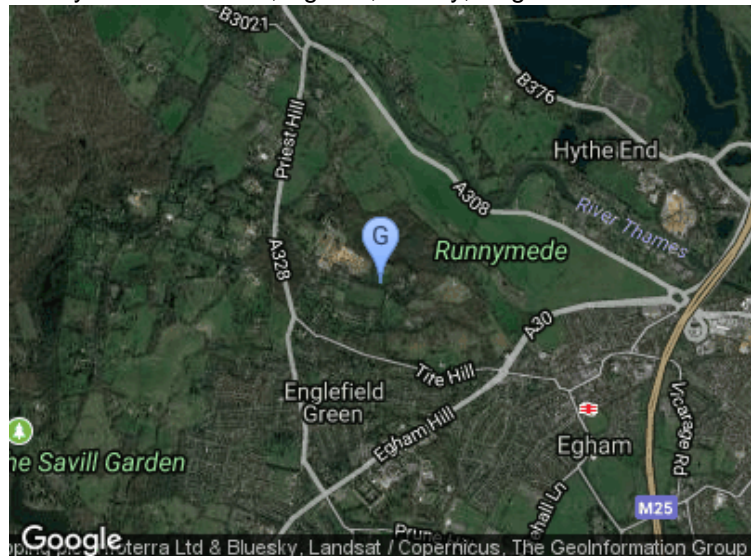
J89253 Pilot Officer (No. 408 Goose Squadron RCAF pilot) Joseph Philip Young (b.1918) of Regina was KIA 19440523 and is commemorated on the Runnymede Memorial near London, England, for airmen from the north European theatre who died with no known grave. Young's Lancaster was shot down near Dulman, Germany, during a night raid on Dortmund. He was the son of Henry (Heinrich Jung), a barber, and Mary (Busch) Young who came from Jugoslavia. Joseph attended St. Josephs school and Balfour Tech and was a salesman for Cheerio Toys & Games when he enlisted at Regina early in 1942.
