Narrative history

L105253 Private (South Saskatchewan Regiment) John Bader (b.1913) of Eatonia was KIA 19440828 at Forêt de la Londe during the pursuit to the Seine and is buried at Bretteville-sur-Laize Canadian war cemetery, Calvados, France. He was the son of Daniel and Mary Bader who came to N31-25-24-W3 south of Glidden in 1918 and later moved to Hanna, Alberta. John was born at Leader, attended Quinney school and was farming when he enlisted at Regina early in 1942.
